The amazing facility we use each year to have Camp Tolton is without their maintenance staff and has reached out for help to prepare for the upcoming camp season and a lifelong parishioner of St. Pat’s who is now homebound has a need of a new deck on the front entrance of her home. On Saturday, March 25th, we are asking all able bodied parishioners and friends to come to St. Pat’s in Clarence at 9 a.m. to organize for the days mission. Lunch will be provided at both locations. The deck project is south of Clarence at the home of Carol Farmer and will consist of demolition and loading of old deck, creating a temporary entry and planning and marking out of a replacement, which will be built on a following date, to be determined. We need men who are willing to lead this project as well as tools for dismantling, a truck and trailer for haul away will be provided. At camp, located north of Clarence, we have a large amount of leaf blowing, raking and stick pick up to do outside as well as interior cleaning and general maintenance of all the cabins and pool house.
