NOTE FROM FATHER BILL...

Catholics in Macon and Shelby counties: We are doing a community parish garden behind the Buhman Center. It is 50 ft. by 150 ft. The produce will be split between whoever works in it, the local food pantry, the senior center, and ICS since they are no longer doing free and reduced meal program. Many parishioners, such as myself, have their own gardens as well. Many don't and many in our community don't and can't. Fresh fruits and vegetables are expensive. They shouldn't be luxury items.

So, I am asking for two things. First as Catholics, we are obliged to the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. One of these is feeding the hungry. Just because I don't need doesn't mean my neighbors don't need it. Remember Jesus saying we will hear the words, "Whatever you did/did not do for the least of my brothers, you did/did not do for me" at the final judgment. So, take some time to help in this endeavor. Also, for those like myself who have gardens, to donate some of it to the three above mentioned groups.

The diocese, through Catholic Charities, has given \$2500 for this project. Next week and the week after we will be planting. We are buying the garden implements we need.

Finally, as a matter of living a stewards way of life, if you would like to contribute money, time, seedlings, and such let me know. I am contributing seeds for squashes, beans, melons, cucumbers, peas, beets, spinach, pumpkins, onions and okra.
