As we continue to strive to meet the needs of all our parishioners, we've decided to form several new ministries to begin in the fall. The first group is the **St. Monica Society**, based on the unceasing prayer and faith of Monica, the mother of St. Augustine, this groups goal is to provide a safe and confidential setting for parents of adult children who are struggling in any capacity and or have fallen away from the church, This monthly support group will be a place to share or listen and pray for one another's families, especially those children, like Augustine, who may seem like a lost product of the world. Our first meeting will be on Monday, August 28th (Feast of St. Augustine) at the Fr. Buhman Center in Shelbina at 6:00 p.m. rotating monthly between Macon and Shelbina.

Frassati Fraternity, inspired by Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, who was a strong young Italian man, and athletic mountain climber and hiker and avid speaker on his love for the Eucharist. This group is for young men ages 15-30 and will meet monthly on Sunday evenings beginning August 6th, at 4:00 p.m. at the Dale Durbin Farm.

All God's Children, a confidential support group for parents of young children with any special needs whether behavioral, physical or mental. This group will meet monthly beginning August 21st at St. Pat's at 6:00 p.m. and welcomes all parents, parishioners and non-parishioners alike. Please note, this does not provide a means of professional counseling but rather a place to talk and listen to parents facing similar circumstances who welcome feedback and prayer.

Fiat, a young women's group focusing on those 15-30, meeting monthly beginning August 6th at 4:00 p.m. on the patio of Immaculate Conception.

Covenant, a ministry to reach married couples, to help build and more fully understand the church's teachings about the beautiful vocation of marriage. This monthly group will begin in September with locations and times to come.
