If you are an employee, volunteer for Church, on a committee, lead a ministry, or a role model in any way as well as a member of an organization or want to participate in parish fundraisers or activities.....

YOU MUST BE VIRTUS COMPLIANT!

Fr. Bill is obliged by the promise of obedience to the Bishop at his priestly ordination to enforce this policy as it comes from the Bishop. He will enforce it - if you have any questions or concerns, please speak directly to Fr. Bill.

NOTE: You don't have to be directly involved or in contact with the youth in the parish! Virtus is a Program designed to help us, as adults, recognize the priority and importance of making sure every child is in a safe environment - it teaches what to look for and how to report issues in the case of suspicion of neglect and abuse. Protecting our children and young adults is our main priority.

- ◆ If you have had the training and need to update your account/forms - and have forgotten your
 - ◆ User ID and password - we can get that from the Diocese.
 - ◆ If you need Virtus training, and need assistance please contact the Parish office.
- ◆ If you do not complete the training program, unfortunately you will not be able to participate, volunteer, committee member, member of an organization or in any ministry/liturgy capacity.

As members of our parish, we have all been asked to become virtus compliant. If you are not working directly with youth, NO background check will be run for you at any time. If you have questions about this or would like help becoming compliant, please call Amanda at 660-415-73623 to schedule.
