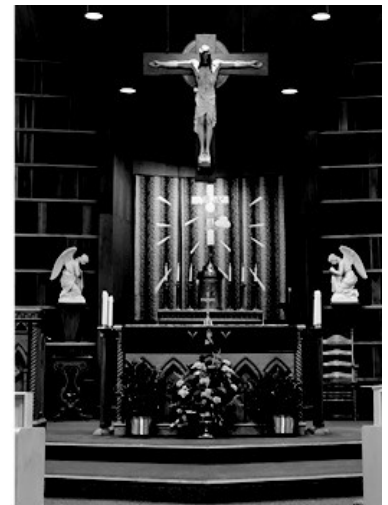
MORE INFORMATION ON BACK
